"We hold these truths to be self evident..."

The Fourth of July celebrates the passage of the Declaration of Independence by the Continental Congress on July 4, 1776. The Declaration announced the separation of the 13 North American colonies from Great Britain.

Here are a few fun facts about the signing of the Declaration of Independence:

- •Only John Hancock actually signed the Declaration of Independence on July 4, 1776. All others signed later.
- •The Declaration of Independence was signed by 56 men from 13 colonies.
- The average age of the Signers of the Declaration of Independence was 45. The youngest was Thomas Lynch, Jr. (27) of South Carolina. The oldest delegate was Benjamin Franklin (70) of Pennsylvania. The lead author of The Declaration, Thomas Jefferson, was 33.
- Seven signers of the Declaration of Independence were educated at Harvard.

Here are a few fun facts about the Fourth of July:

- Congress made Independence Day an official unpaid holiday for federal employees in 1870. In 1938, Congress changed Independence Day to a paid federal holiday.
- The first Independence Day celebration took place in Philadelphia on July 8, 1776. This was also the day that the Declaration of Independence was first read in public after people were summoned by the ringing of the Liberty Bell.
- President John Adams, Thomas Jefferson and James Monroe all died on the Fourth. Adams and Jefferson (both who signed the Declaration) died on the same day within hours of each other in 1826.
- Every Fourth of July the Liberty Bell in Philadelphia is tapped (not actually rung) thirteen times in honor of the original thirteen colonies.


PAINT PARTY

SCAM ALERT

Pay attention folks!! Calls from scammers are at an all time high. Once again, they are targeting Medicare recipients. Remember.....

MEDICARE WILL NEVER CALL YOU UNINVITED TO REQUEST PRIVATE INFORMATION.... but these scammers are out there in full force. We know because they are already calling Seniors here in Granville County. These are some of the things they may tell you when they call.....

- 1. They may falsely tell you that Medicare is again issuing new cards perhaps plastic ones or metal ones. No, they are **NOT**...it's a scam. The scammers may tell you that for them to send your new Medicare card, you need to verify your identity, which may include your Medicare number. If you get a call like this, hang up!
- 2. They may tell you Medicare needs to "verify" your information and may even threaten to cancel benefits. Again...it's a scam. Hang up!
- 3. Scammers are calling some people, claiming your doctor asked them to call. They may even spoof the caller ID to look like they are calling from your doctor's office. In these cases, they may tell you your doctor wants you to have cardiac genetic testing, or some kind of back brace, knee brace, etc. If this were true, your doctor would have talked about it during an appointment. If you get a call like this, hang up. You can call your doctor's office if you have a question about whether it was real.

If you do receive a call like these, call the NC Insurance Commissioner's Office at 855-408-1212 and press 2 to report Medicare fraud.
